

Specimens of Caulerpa trifaria from S Australia

- 1. bases of upright branches showing spines in 3 rows; (A72425) from Outer Harbour
- 2. plant apex showing the three rows (arrowed) of narrow ultimate branches, characteristic of the species (A71481), from Thevenard jetty, West coast (re-floated from a pressed herbarium specimen, hence somewhat shriveled and flattened)
