

GROUP I. PLANTS UN-ATTACHED, BALL-SHAPED/CLUMPED OR TURF SPECIES




 Cladophora coelothrix Kützing — Green mats

Key features

- A. plants consist of dense mats or cushions
- B. wide cells, >80µm wide, many with L/B > 5
 C. apical cells elongate
- (L/B = 3-16)





 4. Cladophora subsimplex Kützing — Green cushions

Key features

- A. small cushions or tufts
- B. *narrow* cells, <*80µm wide*, many with L/B
 >6; runner-like threads with erect side branches
 C. apical cells with a
- *conical point* (L/B = 2-6)
