


## **Details of Anatomy**



Cross sections of Padina fraseri stained blue and viewed microscopically

- 1. blade edge showing the upturned and in-rolled (circinate) edge including a band of hairs (h) (A51069 slide 9666)
- 2. showing the 3 cell rows (1,2,3), with colourless middle (medulla, *med*) containing large cells and hair tufts on *both* sides of the blade, characteristic of this species (A56877 slide 9665)
- 3. a patch (sorus, *sor*) of spores (*sp*), with flimsy covering (indusium, *ind*) torn aside (A51069 slide 9666)
