

Ulva spathulata Papenfuss

Ulva spathulata stained blue and viewed microscopically

- 1. surface view of cells from near the top of the blade. Cells are equal-sided and lie in lines in 2 directions (shown by arrows) (slide 6455)
- 2. cross section through the basal stalk of a blade, showing the 2 cell layers and thick middle layer penetrated by threadlike rhizoids (slide 6457)
