


Details of Anatomy





- 1,2. cross sections through blades, stained blue and viewed microscopically
 - 1. showing 8 regular rows of colourless cells of the middle (medulla, *med*) layer, and a single row of dark cells of the surface (cortex, *co*) layer. A single sporangium (*sp*) and 4 empty sporangial cases are present (slide 9862); hairs *absent*
 - 2. showing "eggs" (oogonia) on the upper surface (slide 9863)
- 3. a blade tip, showing the line of dark dividing cells at the apical fringe (arrowed) (slide 9860)
